The Candidate should be one who:

- is a graduating Stelly's Grade 12 student, graduating in the school year in which the candidacy is considered
- has demonstrated academic success
- has volunteered or had work experience in the field of agriculture with an emphasis on sustainable local food
- is enthusiastic with a strong work ethic and a determined personality
- has personal characteristics which include: empathic listening skills, patience, perseverance, open-mindedness, strong communication skills and is detailed oriented with the ability to problem solve and make difficult decisions.

Candidates are asked to submit:

1. A Stelly's application form
2. A statement of future goals
3. A CV highlighting their education, extra-curricular & volunteer activities
4. A reference letter
5. An unofficial transcript

The Stelly's Scholarship Committee, in consultation with the Fox Family will choose the successful candidate.
